Hudson Maynard Adult Learning Center is seeking a math instructor for the 2018-2019 school year.

You will be teaching math to adult learners who are preparing for the MA High School Equivalency Test, either HiSet or GED.

This is a part-time position, two evenings per week, Tuesday and Thursday from 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm (a total of 6 teaching hours plus 3 hours of paid prep time per week). Commitment is September through June. Program and staff development hours are also provided. Classes are at Hudson High School.

Job Requirements:

Must be licensed to teach high school level math in accordance with Massachusetts K-12 Common Core Standards

Develop and implement class lesson plans based on students' direct needs and learning styles.

Work collaboratively with other teachers in the program to ensure a curriculum that is aligned across levels.

Must be able to work with adult learners with different education levels.
