Since 1971, the Community Learning Center has been helping adults improve their lives, and

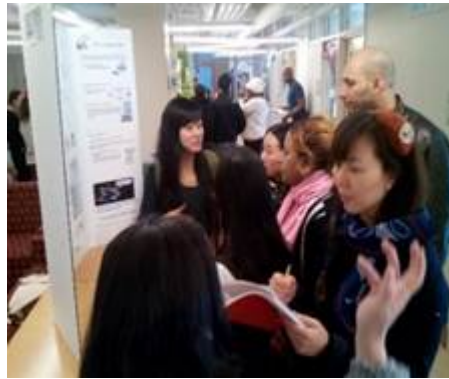
supporting career opportunities and community involvement by providing high quality programs, led by our experienced and diverse staff. Our program design and student outcomes have been recognized throughout the region.
