Job Description:

The full time Adult Basic Education Instructor/Career Advisor (Teacher VII) is responsible for providing individualized and group instruction for male inmates participating in the education program in accordance with grant requirements. The Instructor (Teacher VII) will be responsible for teaching the following content at both a basic level (ABE) and a high school equivalency level (HSE): math, science and social studies. In addition, the instructor will provide career and education advising for all DESE funded students and provide workshops to small group on career exploration.

Qualifications:

Bachelor's Degree in related field with two (2) or more years of experience as a classroom teacher in an adult education or correctional education program required. Bilingual skills are desirable (English/Spanish). Must possess a primary, secondary or ABE teacher license from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts or be working toward such certification. Familiarity with the College and Career readiness Standard for Adult Education. Experience with integrating career awareness into the ABE classroom using contextualized curriculum.
