Hudson Maynard Adult Learning Center is seeking an ABE level ASE instructor for the 2021 -2022 school year. HMALC is a DESE funded program. We provide instructional services to adults who are in Adult Secondary Education (ASE), pre-ASE, and Adult Basic Education.

You will be instructing adult learners who are preparing to take the MA High School Equivalency Test (HiSet or GED), using GED curriculum to teach English Language Arts, Social Studies, History, Science and high school Math.

This is a part-time position, two evenings per week from 6:30 pm to 9:00 pm. Classes are scheduled to be held in-person at Hudson High School, with a remote teaching component.

Weekly paid prep time and program development hours are also provided.

Job Requirements:

Must be familiar with and be able to teach to GLE 9-12 in accordance with the Massachusetts K-12 Common Core Standards, and using the Massachusetts ASE Curriculum Frameworks and the College and Career Readiness Standards for Adult Education.

Must be familiar with using technology for remote teaching (Zoom, WhatsApp, etc)

Develop and implement class lesson plans based on student's direct needs and learning styles. Subjects include English Language Arts, science, social studies and math.

Must be able to assist the students with developing solid close reading skills.

Work collaboratively with other teachers in the program to ensure a curriculum that is aligned across levels.

Should be qualified by DESE licensure standards.

Must be patient, have excellent communication and interpersonal skills and be experienced working with adult learners.

Bachelor degree is required.
