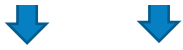


# Curriculum for Adults Learning Math (CALM)

## Sequence for Earning Professional Development Points (PDPs)

Start here



### REQUIRED PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (PD)

**CALM Introduction**  
4 hours, asynchronous online course

OR

**CALM Orientation**  
6 hours, in-person workshop

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### ADDITIONAL PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT (ANY COMBINATION OF OPTIONS BELOW)

**CALM Support series**  
1.5 hrs each, online or in-person

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### REQUIRED ASSIGNMENT

**Reflection Assignment**

This graded assignment requires thoughtful responses to three reflection questions. A rubric is provided for guidance.

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The number of PDPs earned = number of PD hours completed.

Total PD time of Steps 1&2 must add up to at least 10 hours to be eligible for PDPs.
