TASK 1: Complete/Revisit PART 1 of the SABES <u>ELA Unit Plan Template</u> .	 ★ If you have created a section for this unit on your program's Scope & Sequence, transfer that information into the unit plan. ★ If you are working with a unit plan formatted in a different way, transfer that information into the SABES ELA Unit Plan template, making needed revisions as you go. ★ For each row of the UP template, read and carefully consider the guidance provided in the left column. Make revisions as needed. ★ See Examples of Unit Outcomes and Culminating Assessments and use the sentence stems and examples to craft your own.
TASK 2: Align/Revisit ELA learning standards, unit objectives, and assessments.	 ★ Use <u>Aligning ELA Standards, Unit Objectives, and Assessments</u> (a.k.a., SOA Chart) and then copy and paste the last 2 columns into the unit plan template. ★ <u>Developing Unit Objectives</u>. ★ Connect all unit-level assessments to the culminating assessment.
