

## **Giving Feedback:** Self-Assessment

Use the following checklist to self-assess on the key elements of effective feedback. (Mark all statements that apply.)
☐ I collaborate with the learner to choose the focus of my feedback.
☐ We together explore how the feedback focus matters to student learning.
☐ I make notes on the work in question.
☐ I provide feedback as soon as possible after the work takes place.
☐ I attend to the dynamics of cultural or other differences in the feedback
relationship.   I ask learners to describe their choices in the work.
☐ I limit and focus the feedback that I offer.
☐ I ground my feedback in data and observational evidence.
☐ I put aside my judgments and opinions.
☐ I include appreciative feedback as well as areas of concern.
☐ I pause and clarify if the learner seems overwhelmed or confused.
☐ I speak to equity issues in my feedback.
☐ I ask learners to frame my feedback in their own words.
☐ I ask learners what next steps they would like to take.
