Here is how a writing teacher completed her Professional Learning Plan:

Professional Learning Goal:

My professional learning goal is to <u>learn how to give students useful feedback (the right amount of feedback that they can use immediately</u>) so that they will <u>show clear improvement in their</u> <u>essay-writing and the % of students passing their mid-cycle writing assessment increases from 50% to 75%</u>.
