The standards are informed by development in research on second language acquisition, neuroscience, and evidence-based instructional practices; an increased understanding and commitment to diversity, equity and inclusion, and culturally responsive teaching practices; and increased attention to digital literacy demands on both teachers and learners. The accompanying <i>videos (total viewing time for all three videos is approximately 35 minutes)</i> , developed by the SABES ESOL PD Center, provide background about the history of the standards, describe their organization and what has changed in the revision, and how the standards can help guide teachers toward more effective instruction. The <i>Active Viewing Guide</i> offers an engaging facilitated process for individual or team viewing of the videos.

The document integrates elements from the <i>MA ABE Curriculum Framework</i> <i>for ESOL</i> and the <i>College and Career Readiness Standards for Adult Education</i> into one document. The accompanying <i>videos (total viewing time for the 3 videos is 20 minutes)</i> , developed by the SABES ESOL PD Center, provide an overview of the MA ELPS, including why the MA ELPS were developed; the organization of the document, into strands, levels, standards, threads, and benchmarks; the progression of the benchmarks through the levels; and how the MA ELPS can be used for rigorous English language instruction.
