#### **Foundations for New Staff**

### **Sharing Groups**

Sharing groups are a peer-facilitated opportunity for new and experienced staff to network and share resources, questions, and ideas on topics chosen by your colleagues. Each sharing group meets several times per year: participants are encouraged but not required to attend all meetings. Each meeting includes time for general sharing and time for breakout discussions organized by region or program type, including corrections.

- Advisors Sharing Group for anyone whose work includes advising students
- Digital Literacy Sharing Group for staff in any role whose work includes digital literacy or technology integration
- Support Staff Sharing Group for staff working in administration support roles
- **Volunteer Coordinators Sharing Group** for staff in any role whose work includes working with volunteers
- MassSTEP Sharing Group for staff working in any role in a MassSTEP program
- Workplace Education Sharing Group for staff working in any role in a workplace education program

## Coaching
